

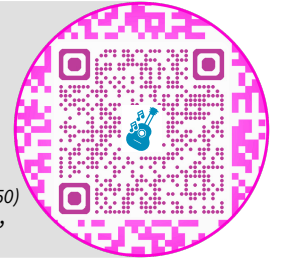

[Bridge]

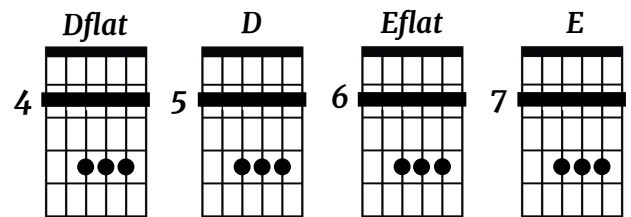
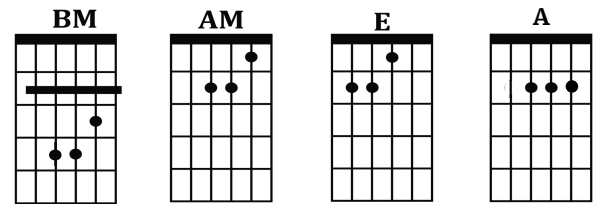
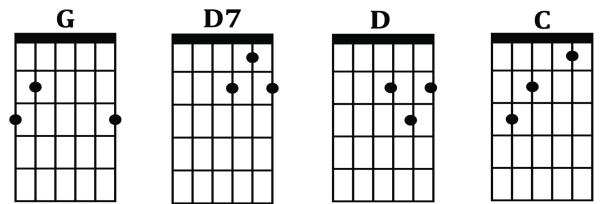
